KITITAS COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 6 – POLICY AND APPLICATION STATEMENT

TITLE: Use of District Stations.

The primary use of the District stations are for the storage and maintenance of firefighting equipment and records for the Fire District. Since the stations were built with taxpayer monies, use of stations to support and benefit the volunteer firefighters and the community may be permitted.

APPLICATION:

Firefighter use of Stations: District stations may be used for regular and special meetings of the District and Firefighters Association. Social events under the auspices of the Firefighters Association are permitted.

Public use of Stations: District stations may be used by non-profit groups for purposes that benefit the community. These events must be consistent with the primary purpose of the station which is public safety. Any such use of the District stations must have prior approval of the Board of Commissioners of the District. Approval is to be given during the course of a regularly constituted meeting of the District Commissioners.

Examples of permitted activities might include, but are not limited to the following:

- Senior activities
- Children's activities
- Voting and voter registration
- Governmental agency meetings

EXCEPTIONS:

No alcoholic beverages are permitted in District stations without special permit arrangements through proper authority.
